NOTE: Any timeframes listed above noted with * that occur within 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM during the Summer Camp dates of 7/3/23 through 8/18/23 (Monday – Friday Only), the following GUEST Policy will apply:

- The term "Guests" refers to children accompanied by a parent or guardian (18 years and older).
- "Guests" who want access to the fenced in preschool playground and/or coned off pre-designated grassy area in "right" field of the large ball-field in the timeframes noted above, <u>MUST</u> first check in at the Newmarket Community Center and provide an ID, preferably a driver's license.
- A Day Park Pass will then be issued to the guest. (Guest passes must be returned that day)
- This check in procedure MUST take place EACH time a guest/s visit, as a new Day Park Pass will be issued.
- Only on the first visit guests will also be required to sign a general liability waiver form. This form will only need to be signed once during the 2023 summer camp season.

WALKING THROUGH THE PARK VIA EMERGENCY ROAD ACCESS

- Guests who only wish to walk through the campus from Terrace Drive and/or the Newmarket Housing Authority to the Newmarket High School (using the emergency road) must check in at the front desk before continuing to their destination.
- Guests who only wish to walk through the campus from the Newmarket High School (using the emergency access road) to the Newmarket Housing Authority and/or to access Terrace Drive, are subject to be stopped by a Newmarket Summer Camp employee wishing to verify their destination.
